Timeline:

This project was composed between November 2010 and February 2011 using Reason Studio's Record program.

Technical Details:

I originally thought these files were lost after my PC crashed. Fortunately, I had exported the stems beforehand. While the original files are actually functional (98 percent), I decided to use the stems for the final mix down to ensure every detail was captured.

Tracklist:

One track was excluded from this release as the tempo did not match the rest of the project. I may release it at a later date.
